Our scholars balance risk-taking in their journey to implement new skills while reflecting on what they learned. We offer Spanish, art, and garden classes to complement our rigorous learning & teaching. After school, we offer coding, engineering, music, theater, clubs, and sports to help our scholars do their best to learn, lead, and succeed.

PVS is in the process of expanding to a TK-8 program for the 2020-2021 school year, creating a community of parents, teachers, and scholars that will prepare our students to transition to high school, college, and beyond.
