Dear Parents / Guardians:

This year your child will have the opportunity to participate in an archery unit at Inderkum High School. The physical education department feels it is an important unit to teach because it promotes discipline, concentration, hand/eye coordination and is a non-traditional life-long activity.

At the beginning of the unit, we will be going over the rules of shooting; concentrating on the safety of all those involved in the class. At the end of the safety instruction, your child will have to pass a written safety test, as well as demonstrate knowledge of the equipment and all commands. If they do not pass the written safety test and performance test, they will have to re-test until they pass. If they cannot pass both tests after one week, they will be given an alternate assignment by their teacher and will not be allowed to shoot.

Also, due to the nature of the activity, if, after your child has been instructed on all safety issues, they choose to do something which places themselves or others in danger, they will immediately be removed from class with a referral, possibly charged with assault through the courts, and will not be allowed to shoot for the remainder of the unit.
