MESSAGE FROM MRS. WHITTEN

Welcome to the 2021 -2022 school year, a new beginning for us all! I would especially like to welcome our families who are new to TK, Kinder, or to our community. Our mission at Heron is to bring joyful learning and academic achievement to all students. We have an exciting year ahead of us after all we've been through together with the COVID -19 Pandemic and the changes that brought to our students' educational experience. It's not all behind us yet, but our

Heron staff and teachers are ready to welcome our students back to school, with the positive energy and excitement of better times ahead. All students will be back on campus in person, following our regular bell schedule. Although we no longer need to socially distance, all students and staff are required by our county health department to wear a mask indoors at all times. Students are free to play outside without a mask! We know that so many students struggled during distance learning, and our Learning Recovery Plan has been designed to provide extra support to the students who need it most. This will be a year that we come together to take care of ourselves and each other. Our Responsive Classroom practices have grown strong at Heron over the years, and now more than ever, we will be focusing on our students' mental health and social-emotional well-being.

DID YOU KNOW?

→ We are a Responsive Classroom school!

Responsive Classroom is an approach to elementary and middle school education that emphasizes social, emotional, and academic growth in a safe school community. More information about the Responsive Classroom approach can be found at

Our STEAM academic focus ensures that students are actively engaged in their learning through inquiry-based science instruction and the integration of technology, engineering, art, and mathematics throughout the day. Our goal is to deliver learning activities that are active, joyful, fun, and appropriately challenging. Students see how this learning is relevant to their lives and take a personal interest in it.



Key Components of Responsive Classroom

- Morning Meeting and Responsive Advisory Meetings: Each TK-6 class gathers together each morning at 8:15AM to greet one another, share news, participate in an activity, and warm up for the day ahead. 7-8 students start each day with Responsive Advisory Meeting at 8:05. Timely arrival to school is extremely important so that all students have the opportunity to be an active participant in the development of their classroom community.
- Rule Creation: Students help create classroom rules that allow all members of the classroom community to reach their learning goals.
- Interactive Modeling: Students are explicitly taught to notice and practice expected behaviors in order to demonstrate and internalize them.
- Positive Teacher Language: Adults use carefully selected, respectful words and tone to promote active learning and self-discipline.
- Collaborative Problem-Solving: Strategies such as conferencing and role-playing are used to help students solve problems and resolve conflict.
- Logical Consequences: Adults respond to misbehavior in a way that respects children, guides them to recognize the effects of their actions, and helps them develop internal controls.

- **Classroom Organization:** The physical space is carefully structured in ways that encourage independence, cooperation, and productivity.
- **Guided Discovery:** Materials are introduced in a way that encourages discovery and creativity.
- **Academic Choice:** Teacher-structured choices are provided to students to help increase motivation, self-direction, and learning.
- **Working with Families:** Family partnerships are essential. Families are invited to share insights and are collaborative partners in their child's education.

Arrival and Dismissal: Middle school starts at 8:05, and TK -6 starts at 8:15. Elementary students should not arrive before 8:00 unless they are eating breakfast in the cafeteria, which opens at 7:45. Students will all be dropped off and picked up at one of our gates, and if students walk or bike to school, they can get their cards scanned by our Jibe volunteers, stationed at each gate. If students need more support getting to their line-up location, parents may walk their students onto campus and then exit immediately once their child has been handed off to a staff member

- **C Hallway Gate:** This entrance/exit near the gym is reserved for our SDC students only.
- **Flagpole/Banfield Gate:** All TK/K students will be dropped off and picked up at this gate and assisted by our IA's. 1st-8th grade Students being transported by vehicle may also use this gate. Parents should stay in their cars and pull up in line to drop off/pick up your child near the flagpole.
- **Minden Gate and MS Gate:** 1st-8th grade walkers/bikers may use these gates; there is no car drop off here- the driveway is for busses and emergency vehicles only. Please do not make an illegal U-turn on Minden under any circumstances. We see this happen often, and it is very dangerous.
- **Heron Park Gate:** 1st-8th grade walkers/bikers may use this gate

COVID Safety Guidelines: As a reminder, we will be following California Department of Public Health Guidelines (CDPH), which includes:

- Parents may now walk their child to class at arrival and dismissal if your child is needing more support.
- All staff and students are required to wear masks properly while inside the building.
- Social distancing is no longer required, which means that students and staff will be passing next to each other in the hallways, and sitting near each other in classes.
- During lunch, students will be able to take off their masks to eat. If weather permits, Heron will have outdoor eating options available for students.



- While outside for recess students do not need to wear their masks. Playground equipment can be shared - there are no outside restrictions.
- Students will be reminded to wash their hands and use hand sanitizer before playing on play structures and sharing items.
- Quarantine requirements have changed. Anyone who is vaccinated and asymptomatic will not need to quarantine. Any other situations will be discussed during contact tracing.

It is important that all staff and students follow the above guidelines to ensure that we are keeping each other safe.

Outdoor Eating Options: Although not required, we will be offering an outdoor eating option to help spread students out a little more, as long as weather permits.

- TK/Kinder: Eating inside the cafeteria, spaced apart since they have their own lunch period and the assistance of IA's
- 1st-4th: Grade levels will alternate each week between indoor and outdoor seating. We will start with 1st grade and 3rd grade eating inside, 2nd and 4th grade eating outside.
- 5th-8th: Students can choose their own seating - inside or outside

→ **Parking Lot Safety-** Please only park your car on the street or in a **MARKED PARKING SPACE**. Please do not leave your car parked and unattended in the middle of the parking lot. This blocks other drivers in and backs up the parking lot into the street. Most importantly, it limits visibility of students and creates a dangerous situation. Please remember the bus lane on Minden is reserved for our school busses only; that may not be used for pick up or drop off.

HERON SCHOOL ATHLETIC PROGRAM

Parent Information 2021-22

Thank you for your interest in having your student participate in our athletic program! We look forward to seeing our students compete and enjoy learning and playing sports here at Heron. Our sports program is for 4th-8th grade students.

Each year the Natomas Unified School District requires that each student have a Student Athlete Clearance Packet completed prior to being eligible to tryout or participate in a school-sponsored sports program. Part of the clearance packet is a physical form that needs to be signed by your child's physician. It is very important that you plan ahead to have this completed by the posted deadlines.*

As we approach each sport a permission slip will be available for your student to take home to have you sign showing your authorization to participate. This permission form is required for each sport that your child would like to participate in. The Student Athlete Clearance Packet is only completed once per year and is due by the deadline of the first sport your child plays. All packets and permission slips are to be turned in to the Kerry House in the school office. Only fully completed packets will be accepted.

Completed Student Athlete Clearance Packets can be turned in anytime after the first day of school.

Please make sure to check the Friday Flyer each week for information regarding upcoming sports as well as weekly schedules. Information and the full schedules are posted on the Heron website as the information is available.

IN THE SPOTLIGHT: Away For the Day Cell Phone Policy

At Heron, we have an “Away For the Day” cell phone policy. Students are still allowed to bring their phones to school, but they must remain turned off and in their backpacks during the instructional day- from the first bell to the last bell. After viewing the powerful *Screenagers* documentary for the last two years with our families and 5th -8th grade classes, the teachers and I decided it was time to make a change. We were finding so many instructional uses for students’ personal devices throughout the day that before long, many students got accustomed to having their phones out all day. This meant



more distraction and social media posting during the school day, and less meaningful interaction with each other. We feel our “Away For the Day” cell phone policy is the right thing to do to ensure our students are given a safe and welcoming learning environment. Students are given a reminder if they forget and take their phone out; after that, they will need to turn their phone into the office. On the first offense, students may pick up their phone after school. After that, the phone will only be returned to a parent who comes to pick it up. Please refrain from texting or calling your student during the school day; if you need to contact your child, call the front office at 916 -567-5680, and we will be happy to help.
